### **INSTRUCTIONAL MANUAL ON HOW TO SUPERSEDE HOSPITAL PROTOCOL**

The first and foremost recommendation that we offer, is to be calm and to relaxed. The propaganda that is being utilized to fuel this agenda is strictly fear based. It is designed to cause panic and hysteria, which heightens and intensifies the fear of the idea of sickness, turning it into a mental and physical malady.

One thing that is absolutely imperative, is to prepare an **advance directive**, have it notarized and recorded in your county seat so that it is on record and stands as law regarding the prescription of any treatment, as well as who has power of attorney, by appointment, to advocate on your behalf. This is crucial to have done immediately in the midst of this so-called “pandemic.”

**Pro Medical Freedom** is committed to seeing that everyone has the necessary protective measures in place and we will be glad to help and advise you to construct the strongest advance directive possible to protect you from the tyrannical protocols of these hospitals.

In the event that an advance directive **does not** formally exist, one must follow and apply these very crucial steps before stepping in to advocate for a loved one:

1. Acquire a copy of the attending hospital’s bylaws and their advance directive form. Some find the **state form** is better as it offers the option to ascribe more direct details for prescription of treatment.
2. Once the advance directive form is completed, be sure to sign it properly and have it notarized immediately, with at least **two witnesses** to sign. It is also a good idea, to give the advance directive stronger standing, to have it recorded in your local county seat of residence. That gives the directive the same bearing and effect as law.

3. Before arriving to the hospital, place a call to the hospital and alert them that you have an advance directive that you are going to present and serve them. Bring two copies. Have them stamp both copies. Take your stamped copy, make a copy to retain for your records, and mail the advance directive to the attention of the administrators overseeing the care of your loved one both CERTIFIED and REGISTERED mail.
4. Every state has a law that allows the presence of a support person at ALL TIMES to be with a patient. Do not allow the hospital to tell you otherwise. Pro Medical Freedom can provide you with a letter and exhibits that you can serve them that will cause them to stand down.
5. If at any time the hospital refuses to honor an advance directive under any circumstances, you must contact an attorney and begin the negotiations to have an **emergency injunction and order** drawn up to be presented to a judge and then served to the hospital to put estoppel on the hospital's orders.
6. Here is the treatment protocol that must be clearly articulated upon any advance directive, injunction and/or order:
  - BiPAP Respiratory Machine
  - Or a Philips Trilogy 100 Portable Ventilator
  - Or a Philips Respironics Trilogy 202 Ventilator
  - Or a Philips Evo Portable hospital-to-home Ventilator
  - Or a CPAP Respiratory Machine
  - Recommended milligram dosage (per patient weight) of Ivermectin once a day.
  - 200 Milligrams of Hydroxychloroquine twice a day.
  - Monolaurin
  - Oregano Oil (80-90% Carvacrol)
  - Vitamin D

- Vitamin C
- Zinc
- Antibiotics
- Steroids

7. Another important factor that must be clearly asserted on the advance directive, injunction and/or order, is that a copy of ALL medical records including, lab reports, doctor's notes, nurse's notes and vitals must be delivered to the patient's advocate post haste.

In closing, the ultimate goal is to utilize the right legal process and protocol to get the patient strong and competent and out of the clutches of the tyrannical protocol of the hospitals. The hospital, by law, must see the patient discharged with all the necessary accoutrements, including oxygen, to transfer to the patient's home or the residence of a family member or friend. In order to accomplish this, the advocate must contact the hospital's patient advocate and sign a release form that absolves the hospital from any responsibility of the patient post discharge.

Another good alternative to relieve the patient from the hospital's protocol is to get them under hospice care. Under hospice care, the leniency to treat the patient as needed is much more feasible.

Be sure to inquire of patient advocacy in the hospital what the options are regarding hospice care. The hospital has a bounden duty by law, under the direction of the advance directive, to provide assistance in seeing a patient transferred to hospice service by order of the advocate by and through the advance directive.
